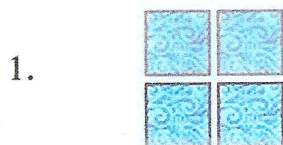

DOUBLE QUARTET BLOCK:

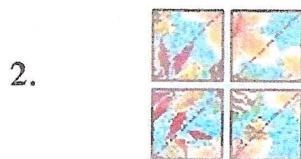
Each finished block measures 12" squares. ($12 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished).

You will need to furnish a "Wildflower print" as your medium tone and a tone-on-tone to blend with your wildflower print in a darker shade for your dark tone. I will furnish your background fabric.

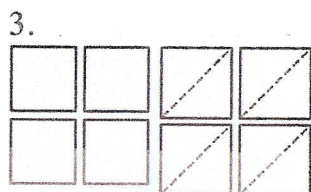
Cutting Instructions:



1. From the dark fabric, cut four $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

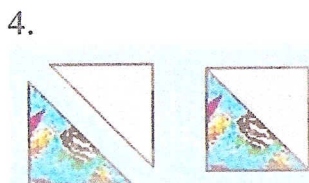


2. From the wildflower print, cut four $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut these squares from one corner to the opposite corner to make eight triangles.



3. From the background fabric, cut four $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares and four $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut the larger squares from one corner to the opposite corner to make eight triangles.

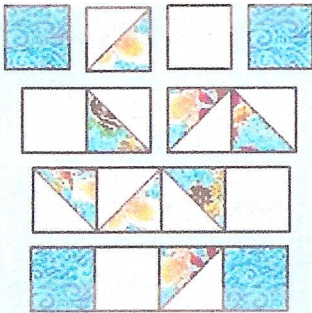
Piecing Instructions:



4. With right sides together and using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance, sew one of the wildflower triangles to one of the background triangles. (Refer to

graphic 4). Press to the darker side. Repeat with the other seven triangle pairs.

Assembly instructions:



5. Referring to the layout in graphic 5, piece the units together into a finished block. Sew pieces into rows first, then combine the rows to finish the block. Pin at the intersections to ensure precise points.

Your completed unfinished block will measure $12 \frac{1}{2}$ ". 12" after sewn into a quilt!
